



Inspection Coordinator

- Prepare inspection scope of works in liaison with the Operations Manager
- Attend client representatives meetings
- Liaise with the ROV supervisor to ensure correct data gathering equipment sensors are fitted to the ROV and liaison with offshore client representatives
- Responsibility for the offshore operation, planning inspection activities for maximum efficiency, QC and data back up
- Create and transmission of daily and weekly reports including daily logs, personnel timesheets, daily and anomaly reports including photographs and video clips
